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TAX RECEIPTS FROM MINEWORKERS' PENSION SCHEME

Thank you for your request of 29 June 2024 for information about the amount of tax paid by the Mineworkers' Pension Scheme over the last 10 years. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act.

We have searched our records and can confirm that we do not hold the information you requested about the Mineworkers' Pension Scheme as it does not fall within the scope of our audit work on the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero. You may also be interested to note on page 25 of the <u>MPS 2023 report and accounts</u> under **Taxation**, that 'the Scheme is a registered Pension Scheme under Chapter 2 of Part 4 of the Finance Act 2004 and is therefore exempt from income tax and capital gains tax'.

I hope this response is helpful. Your specific request is reproduced in **Annex A** for reference. **Annex B** sets out the steps you may wish to take if you are not satisfied with the way we have handled your request for information under FOIA.
